LABOUR EXPLOITATION AND WORK-RELATED CRIME: A PROBLEM ANALYSIS AND PREVENTION FRAMEWORK.

Preventing labour exploitation requires a coordinated effort, and should engage all relevant authorities and actors across three strategies:

1

Victim-oriented by reducing recruitment and removing the root causes of labour exploitation: includes awareness programmes for potential victims, as well as victim identification and assistance.

**Buyer**-oriented by shrinking the market and the profitability: target both personal and corporate buyers. 3

**Offender**-oriented by raising the risks and reducing the rewards:

may be achieved by a mix of criminal justice and administrative probes that benefits from increased information sharing between authorities and across borders.
