HopeNow is able to...

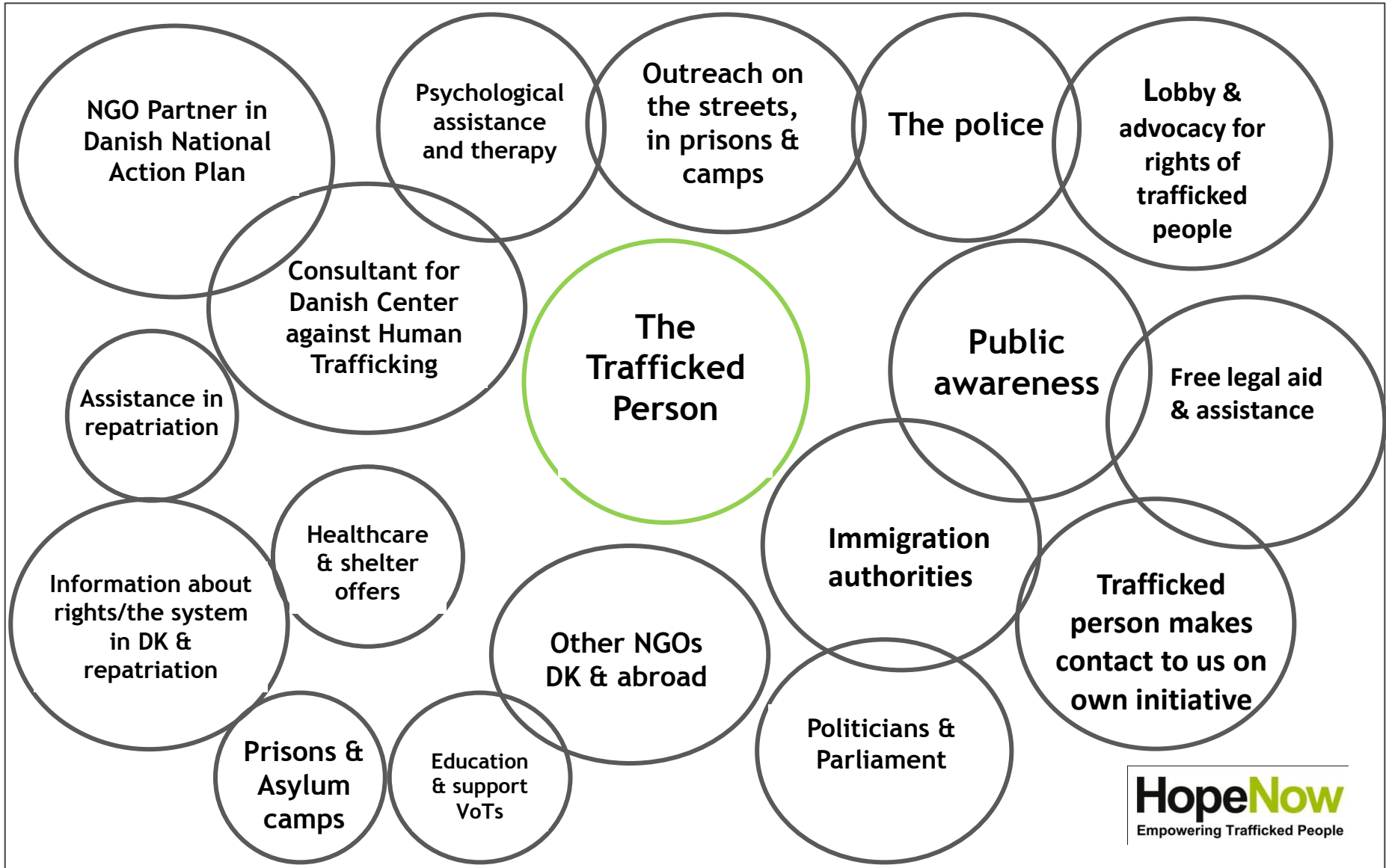
- Offer direct assistance & support to trafficked people
 - Bridgebuild between the target group, authorities and other actors
 - Act as cultural mediator
 - Gather knowledge & data about new developments & trends
 - Share knowledge with State authorities
 - Gain access to people who would not otherwise be identified as trafficked
 - Gain trust & build relationship with target group
 - Raise public awareness of trafficking & related crimes

- To effectively prevent exploitation, re-trafficking and re-victimization



In 2013 HopeNow ...

- **met 366 people from our target group on the street, more than 30 men & women in custody or prison and more than 50 in the asylum camps**
- **identified 23 people of the total of 76 people officially identified as trafficked by Danish Authorities**

Outcomes & gains

- Cooperation between civil society & the State at several levels
- Combat human trafficking
- Provide sensible responses with assistance to needs of trafficked people
- Victims are not re-victimized and re-trafficked
- Prevent crime and human rights violations
