### **Estonia: ISPCAN Congress**

### **Italy: Observatory for Security against Acts of Discrimination**

OSCAD was established to respond operationally to the demand for security of people belonging to "vulnerable categories". The main objectives are to facilitate the filing of complaints on hate crimes, to carry out a fruitful monitoring and to raise awareness, train and constantly update law enforcement officers' skills to combat the phenomenon of under-recording.
