Objectives



- To increase the safety in residential houses, housing estates and public area
- To eliminate socio-pathological phenomena at schools and to increase their safety while establishing active assistance and providing education for the target groups
- 3. To establish an advisory centre for the target groups

Project Outcomes



- Increased safety in town as well as in its educational facilities.

- 3. Flexible resolution of crisis situations at schools
- 4. 82% of students revealed their interest for prevention and counseling
- 5. Creation of an advisory centre at the Municipal Police Headquarters
- 6. Growing media coverage both on local and national level

Project Outcomes




- 7. Presentation in 5 TV stations and 1 radio station

- 11. Established cooperation with a University theory and practice in the field of Crime Prevention


