PROMOTIVE MATERIALS

LET'S BE DIFFERENT BUT STILL EQUALS WHEN IT COMES TO OUR RIGHTS...

Etiquette in everyday communication with people with disabilities

- ask the person what's the best way to help her/him
- don't avoid shaking hands with the person with artificial or amputated hand – shake hands by touching
- talk directly to the person
- talk normally - don't be afraid of wrong words
- sit down while talking to a person in a wheelchair so you can look her/him in the eyes
- if you don't understand a person who has difficulty speaking, don't pretend - ask her/him to repeat
- speaking slowly and directly to a person with hearing impairment; write her/him a note
- say your name to a person with vision impairment - offer your hand to lean on to help them move
- make contact with a person with hearing impairment by touch – write large capital letters on her/his palm
- don't ask personal questions
- be considerate and patient
- don't overpraise people with disabilities for doing daily living tasks
- give your position in a queue
- offer your seat in public transport- help with enter and exit
- don't touch aids and appliances (personal space)
- don't pet a guide dog while it's "working"
- respect drivers with disabilities – don't park in their spots
- treat them as equals because they are equal

UNKNOWN PERSON AT THE DOOR:

- police officer
- person who works in Elektra, Komunalac
- pension insurance, Centar za socijalnu skrb
- life insurance salesman
- nurse
- various salesmen



BE CAREFUL/CHECK/ASK FOR:

- ask for the person's name and identification documents
- don't believe that "expensive things" are sold cheaply (massagers and other medical tools, insurance, gold and other valuable items)
- give your personal information to no one
- don't sign any documents you don't understand
- if someone's complaining of not feeling well, don't let them in your house – call an ambulance
- if you arrange a meeting in your home, also invite a member of your family or a neighbour
- don't keep substantial amounts of money or valuables in your house
- if someone asks for money on the pretext of having a disability or having a low-income, keep in mind that you are not helping that person by giving her/him money (that person is often forced to beg for someone who doesn't need help)

IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS IN "GOOD INTENTIONS" OF AN UNKNOWN PERSON, CONTACT US, DON'T KEEP SILENT, REPORT IT

IF YOU WANT TO SELL "EXPENSIVE" THINGS/SERVICES CHEAPLY

ARRANGE A MEETING WITH YOU VIA TELEPHONE AND ASK FOR PERSONAL INFORMATION

BRING GOOD NEWS ABOUT WINNING PRIZE COMPETITIONS, PENSION INCREASES/RESIDUES

COLLECT DEBTS ON THE SCENE

ASK FOR HUMANITARIAN AID

ENTER YOUR APARTMENT/HOUSE ON THE PRETEXT OF NOT FEELING WELL




REPORT:

- THREATS,
- THEFTS,
- BLACKMAIL,
- DOMESTIC VIOLENCE,
- DOUBTS OF SEXUAL OFFENCE,
- OTHER CRIMINAL BEHAVIOUR

POLICE NEED YOUR HELP



Try to remember/note as many details about the suspect/perpetrator as possible (height, age, clothes, scars, distinguishing features, vehicle...) and, of course, tell about it to someone you trust without fear, shame...

OPREZ

NE DOZVOLITE DA SE NETKO NEZAKONITO KORISTI VAŠIM OSOBNIM PODACIMA !!!

- Osobne podatke ne dajte putem telefona bez obzira na to kako se netko predstavlja: kao djelatnik Vaše banke, predstavnik socijalne skrbi, teleoperator, osoba koja nudi unosan posao, osoba koja Vas obavještava da ste dobili nagradu...
- Papire na kojima se nalaze Vaši osobni podaci uništite prije bacanja u smeće.
- Osobe koje Vam na kućnom pragu nude različite usluge (npr. povoljne tarife za telefon, mobitel ili struju, očitavanje brojila, prodaju medicinskih pomagala, posteljine i sl.) zatražite da se predstave važećim dokumentom.
- Budite oprezni prilikom unošenja osobnih podataka na Internetu: nemojte objavljivati svoje osobne podatke na društvenim mrežama, prilikom popunjavanja upitnika/anketa i sudjelovanja u nagradnim igrama provjerite autentičnost web stranice na koju unosite podatke, ne odgovarajte na e-mailove koji od Vas zahtijevaju osobne podatke...
- ODMAH prijavite gubitak ili krađu dokumenata na kojima se nalaze osobni podaci !!!

POSTATI ŽRTVA KAZNENOG DJELA I dobit račun ili obavijest o ovrši zbog neplaćenih računa, a da niste sklopili nikakav pretplatnički ugovor!!!

EVALUATION

PROCES EVALUATION

- The number of the involved in project activities was achieved completely
- Survey was carried out among the participants who rated all the activities with the highest rating
- Police officers included in the survey stated that workshops were extremely useful
- The representatives of senior citizens associations and people with disabilities associations **proposed the Project to be continued.**

IMPACT EVALUATION

- Comparison of figures to a five-year period before the implementation of the Project
- After implementation of the Project the number of elderly and people with disabilities victims of offences has decreased by **17%.**

EVALUATION → Project recommended and adopted in the whole territory of the Republic of Croatia.


