Statistics...

- •69% declare that they witnessed cyberbullying
- •55% added strangers in their friends' list
- •27% met face to face with people they met online
- •33% seen sexual images online
- •8% were asked to talk about sex online
- •5% were asked to send erotic pictures

We run a counselling to children and parents through a helpline : ctrl_AJUTOR




We organize workshops and sessions for children, parents, teachers, and professionals on online risks encountered by minors and preventivie measures

6400 people benefitted from counselling







Helpline ctrl_AJUTOR

Experts in online safety answer children's questions regarding safe Internet use and new tech.

6400 cases.

Most frequent: cyberbullying, security and technical information, data theft.

Hotline esc_ABUZ

The Illegal content reporting hotline is based on a protocol between Save the Children Romania and the Romanian General Inspectorate of Police, as well as the Authority for Child Rights and Adoption.

2017: 2555 cases out of which 1421 CSAM.



Illegal content

- Child Sexual abuse Images (Art. 374, Codul Penal, Pornografia infantilă).
- Adult Pornography accessible to minors(Lege privind prevenirea si combaterea pornografiei Nr. 196/2003)







Processing reports

Reports are handled with special attention to confidentiality and data safety.

Accessing the content by INHOPE standards.



Registering report

- Verifying content
- Verifying server location

Confirmed report

- Alerting authorities
- Transmitting data to partener hotline/Interpol

Classifying raport

Verifying report : content removal.






Country of hosting


