2. Main theme

SafeSchool is a tool that prevents reports and protects against any type of violence or abuse against children / adolescents.

The SafeSchool project consists of a software extension built into the Chrome Internet browser.

6. Short summary of the project (**max. 100 words**)

The SafeSchool project consists of a software extension built into the Chrome Internet browser.

A tool (represented by a pet - a robot) that has the ability to be aware of the prevention and protection of children 24 hours a day.

Behind this tool there is a great team of Psychologists permanently connected (24 hours a day) and in case of need (in the most serious cases) the Spanish Police intervenes directly for the safety of each of the victims.

SafeSchool becomes akin to home alarm billboards to criminals.

SafeSchool includes a section on prevention and advice that gives messages to teachers and students related to risk prevention on different topics: abuse, mistreatment, gender violence, harassment, suicide ... etc.

This tool can be used in tutorials as prevention and seeking help in any criminal situation.

7. Project description

Victims have 3 different forms of direct communication: via telephone, via email and via online chat 24 hours a day.

This tool is connected to all children's devices in schools and at home.

With the pandemic, many schools have opted for "one-to-one" device models and that allows all children to have access to this tool.

And that allows any child to ask for help anytime, anywhere and receive an immediate response.

If we add to that that there is a systemApp, they can use the tool on any type of device (phones, tablets, Chromebooks, computers ...)

Having SafeSchool in a school will also allow everyone to carefully consider the possibility of committing any crime at that school.

8. Project objectives

Prevent any type of violence / abuse against children in any situation and space.

That school as a space where children spend most of their time each day is the safest space that exists for them.

But that children have a key tool to be able to go if they need help.

That the tool also serves to prevent and educate. You can work with her from schools and from home.

That in case of serious situations, police forces can intervene directly to stop and redirect any type of crime.

Make it a tool accessible to everyone both at a technical and economic level (it is a free tool)

9. Project outcome

There are internal studies of the schools linked to the project that coincide in a lower incidence of criminal acts covered by prevention and education.
