Counteracting trafficking in human beings, protecting young people from becoming a victim of human trafficking

6. Short summary of the project (**max. 100 words**)

Holidays is a period of looking for a casual job, traveling abroad, and at the same time carelessness and willingness to experience an adventure, which increases the risk of being used for slave labor or prostitution. Young people are particularly at risk of falling victim to trafficking. Lack of life experience and youthful carelessness make it easy to manipulate and cheat.

Having regard to the above, the Prevention Department of the Provincial Police Headquarters in Gorzów Wielkopolski, in 2019, planned the implementation of a preventive project entitled *Prevention of trafficking in people*. The main assumption of the project is to conduct preventive meetings with youth from secondary schools in the Lubuskie province - potential victims of human trafficking as well as information and education campaign in the mass media.

7. Project description

The Prevention Department of the Provincial Police Headquarters in Gorzów Wielkopolski developed the assumptions of the preventive project and the schedule of activities approved by the Provincial Police Commander in Gorzów Wielkopolski. A letter was also sent to the Lubuskie School Superintendent asking for written acceptance of the undertaking.

The Prevention Department of the Provincial Police Headquarters in Gorzów Wielkopolski acquired information and educational materials on human trafficking from the "La Strada" Foundation (leaflets, brochures) as well as the Lubuskie Province Governor's Office (posters, leaflets) and handed them to the local police units of the Lubuskie province. The field units of the Lubusz garrison until the end of April 2019 will establish contact with the directors of secondary schools in order to present the concept of preventive activities and establish a schedule of meetings with young people. In the first place, the activities will be addressed to students of industry schools and technical schools, potentially the most threatened by the phenomenon of trafficking in human beings. The meetings will be carried out by police officers - specialists in social prevention and community police officers from district and municipal police headquarters of Lubuskie province. During meetings with young people, police officers disseminate information and educational materials in the field of human trafficking.

The implementation of the project will be accompanied by an education and information campaign in the mass media, conducted in cooperation with the Press Team of the Provincial Police Headquarters and press officers of the district and municipal police headquarters of Lubuskie province. On the websites of the Lubusz police and in local media, information about the project itself as well as advice will be placed for potential victims of human trafficking.

8. Project objectives

- Limiting the phenomenon of human trafficking in the Lubuskie Province.
- Shaping youth victimology awareness.
- Protecting young people from becoming a victim of human trafficking.

9. Project outcome

The results of the project will be determined after its completion - until July 12, 2019.

10. Start and end project, timescales and key milestone dates

The project is carried out in three stages:

1. Project preparation, preparation of a preventive meetings schedule - until May 2, 2019.
2. Implementation of preventive meetings as well as information and education campaigns - until June 19, 2019.
3. Summary and evaluation of the project - until July 12, 2019.
