Trends:	Studies showed a significant increase in the fear of crime until the mid-1990s, particularly in eastern Germany. But since then it has noticeably dropped. The actual crime situation and its subjective perception are widely diverging. Although violent crime makes up for only about 3% of the overall crime rate and is largely restricted to male juveniles and adolescents, also segments of the population which are less threatened have a heightened fear of becoming the victim of violent crime.
