

<b>Relevant legislation:</b>	<p><b>§ 200. Robbery</b></p> <p>(1) A person who by using violence takes away movable property of another with the intention of illegal appropriation shall be punished by 2 to 10 years' imprisonment.</p> <p>(2) Same act, if:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) the object of the act is a firearm, ammunition, explosive substance or radiation source,</li> <li>2) the object of the act is a narcotic drug or psychotropic substance or a precursor thereof,</li> <li>3) the object of the act is an object of great scientific, cultural or historical significance,</li> <li>4) the act is committed by a person who has previously committed robbery, or manslaughter in connection with robbery or for the purpose of any other personal gain, or extortion,</li> </ol>
