Relevant legislation:	<p>Sexual crimes are provided and punished by the following articles of the Greek penal code:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - article 336 "Rape" - article 337 "Offences against sexual dignity" - article 338 "Abuse in fornication" - article 339 "Seduction of children" - article 342 "Abuse of minors in fornication" - article 343 "Fornication by abuse of power" - article 345 "Incest" - article 347 "Fornication against nature" - article 348 "Facilitation of debauchery", - article 349 "Bawdry" - article 350 "Exploitation of prostitute" - article 351 "White slavery" <p>Also, certain forms of sexual crimes, are punished according to the provisions of the Law 3064/15-10-2002 on "Human trafficking, crimes against sexual freedom, the pornography of minors and more generally the economic exploitation of sexual life and aid of the victims of these crimes" and according to the article 323 of the Penal Code on "Human Trafficking" under the title: "Crimes against personal freedom"</p>
Trends:	<p>According to the Greek penal code sexual crimes are provided in the 19th chapter under the title: "Crimes against sexual freedom and crimes of economic exploitation of sexual life".</p> <p>During 2006, the following sexual crimes were recorded:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Rapes: committed 182; attempts 89; successfully investigated crimes of rape (committed and attempted) 219; arrested perpetrators 236. 2. Other sexual crimes (i.e.: fornication, offences against sexual dignity, seduction of children, incest, provocation of scandal by indecent action, facilitation of debauchery, exploitation of a prostitute and bawdry): committed 468; attempts 3; successfully investigated 359; arrested perpetrators 720.
