Main policy page:	Vehicle crime includes more and more laundering of the proceeds of criminal activities in recent times. In this way the stolen vehicles with altered identity are legally entering the EU market.

Trends:	<p>Trend of car thefts in the territory of the Slovak Republic for the period 1990 – 2013 is illustrated by the graph below. Term “appearance” means the number of offences in the monitored period and term “resolved” means the number of accusations of crimes raised against a particular person. The highest appearance of car thefts in Slovakia was recorded in the year 1993, when it reached the amount of 9 700 vehicles. After this year the appearance of thefts was with small variations slowly declining to 2002 when it stopped at the amount of 5 099 vehicles. In 2002 it began again slowly grow, so there were adopted the measures which caused the decrease of thefts to the historically lowest amount of 2431 vehicle thefts in 2013. This number is the lowest since 1990. Under the “appearance” we understand the number of crimes in given period of time and under “resolved” we understand the number of accusations of a crime against certain person. The number of found stolen vehicles and returned to origin owners is not encountered to the number of cleared cases.</p>
